



ONLINE & IN-PERSON VOTING INSTRUCTIONS

for the 51st Annual Meeting | May 6, 2026

VOTING RULES & ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to vote, members must be:

- at least 18 years of age;
- a member of Community First Credit Union prior to February 6, 2026;
- and either an individual account holder or the first person listed on a joint account.

Each member is allowed one vote, no matter how many accounts are held at the credit union. Voting by proxy is not allowed.

Only eligible voting members with Qualifying Information will receive a ballot or be allowed to vote.

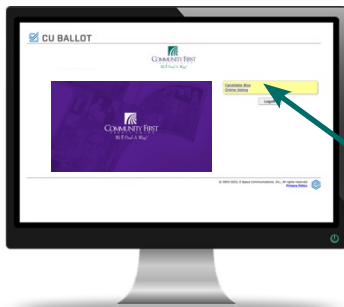

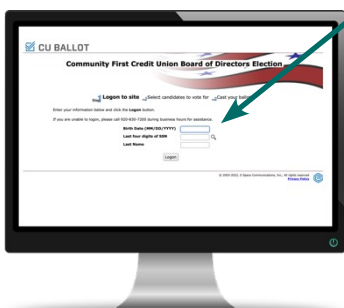

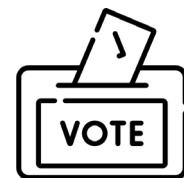
VOTING ONLINE



1. Join the Annual Meeting from the link provided in your email.
2. When it's time to vote, click the voting link to the right of the video (or below if on a mobile device) to open a new tab/window.
3. To verify eligibility, enter your **Qualifying Information** when prompted. Only eligible members are able to log in to vote.



4. Ballots are cast by checking boxes next to the candidate(s) of your choice. Members have the opportunity to review choices before officially submitting their ballot.



VOTING IN PERSON

Eligible members will be provided a paper ballot at the time of registration for the Annual Meeting.

These ballots will be collected by volunteers during the early stages of the meeting and combined with the results from the online voting.
