Community First CU honored with Raddon financial strength award 14 consecutive years

Community First Credit Union has been honored with the 2022 Crystal Performance Award by Raddon, a Fiserv Company, during its annual recognition of the top U.S. credit unions for financial performance. It marks the 14th consecutive year Community First has received the award for financial strength.

It recognizes the good stewardship of the resources of the credit union our members own.” She received the award at the Raddon CEO Forum in Laguna Beach, CA.

“The Crystal Performance Awards are a measure of individual credit union success, but also give a holistic perspective of the entire industry,” said Bill Handel, general manager and chief economist of Raddon. *“We see that even in the face of recovery from the pandemic and a whole new slate of challenges on the horizon, credit unions continue to adapt and embrace innovative ways of providing financial services. According to Raddon, which has been providing financial institutions with research-based solutions since 1983, the award is the only nationwide benchmark of its kind and is based on performance metrics focused on service, member relationships, and more.
